

SPARKLING}

Sparkling wine can be very different stylistically reflecting their place of origin. Prosecco is only made in Italy and is generally light and crisp with mild fruit characteristics. Sparkling rose is made in contact of the skins and has deeper acidity and broader body. True Champagne is only from the Champagne region in France which houses the most expensive & celebrated bubbles in the world.

PINOT GRIGIO & PINOT GRIS}

Pinot Gris & Pinot Grigio are interchangeable. However, it's useful to know that Pinot Gris implies a fruity 'French' style and Pinot Grigio to suggest a drier 'Italian' style.

SAUVIGNON BLANC}

Depending on how ripe the Sauvignon Blanc grapes are when the wine is made, the flavor will range from zesty lime to flowery peach. What makes Sauvignon Blanc unique from other white wines are its other herbaceous flavors like bell pepper, jalapeño, gooseberry and grass.

CHARDONNAY}

The Chardonnay grape is very neutral, with many of the flavors commonly associated with the grape being derived from such influences as terroir and oak. It can be lean, crisp, and mineral with noticeable acidity and flavors of green apple and pear. In warmer locations, the flavors change developing a buttery profile.

CABERNET SAUVIGNON}

In cooler climates, Cabernet tends to produce wines with blackcurrant notes that can be accompanied by mint and cedar. In more moderate climates the blackcurrant notes are often seen with black cherry and plum. While in very hot climates, the current flavors can veer towards the over-ripe and “jammy” side.
